



MUSIC SCHOLARSHIPS

There is an application form for a Music Scholarship which should be completed and returned to the 11+ Admissions Officer in the Senior School by 15 November 2008.

Candidates will be required:

1. Either to perform two contrasting pieces of their own choice on one instrument;

Or to perform one piece on their main instrument and another on their second instrument. Performance on the main instrument should be at the standard equivalent to Associated Board Grade V.
2. To sing a simple folk song of their own choice, pleasantly and in tune (preferably unaccompanied)
3. To do sight reading and aural tests. Both of these tests will be of Grade V standard.

All parts of the examination are important and must be prepared by all candidates.

Candidates summoned for the practical tests, which will be held on **Saturday 31 January 2009**, will need to have reached a satisfactory standard in the English and Mathematics papers of the Entrance Examination.

The times of the practical tests will be notified to successful candidates after the Entrance Examination.

The candidates are invited for interview on a separate day from their practical music test.

The school will provide an official accompanist, and all candidates who need an accompanist must make use of his/her services.

It will not be necessary for scholarship holders to have individual instrumental lessons at North London Collegiate School if they wish to continue with their present music teachers, but they must participate in the corporate musical life of the school.
