Central to the ethos at North London Collegiate School is the provision of bursary places to allow bright girls to benefit from the world-class education on offer. Since its foundation in 1850, North London has been committed to providing an accessible, affordable education for able girls.

Bursary support is offered for up to 100% of fees. Funding is means-tested, and is awarded to girls entering Year 7 or Year 12. We also support families with girls in Year 10 who are experiencing financial hardship and cannot meet the full cost of school fees.

Unlike many independent schools, North London does not currently have an endowment and is dependent on philanthropic support to help raise money for bursaries and other important projects.
